WORCESTER, MASS.—A Worcester WCCATV Channel 13 show, “Imagine Worcester and the World,” is making waves globally, showcasing the wisdom that children have to give adults and keeping the youngsters safe to express themselves. The organization behind the show is fundraising this season, to grow their audience area internationally in the upcoming year.

In recent world events, children have been retraumatized and put at risk to expose events in their areas, and Virginia Swain, host of the WCCA show, saw that program as an opportunity.
